Story about the ‘end of the world’

What would you do if the end of the world was coming?

- Isaiah prophesied around 740 BC. Although Israel was prosperous, it was spiritually bankrupt.
- God told Isaiah that the people would not listen
- Isaiah had a vision, and believed in it.

Job’s was a ‘pulled man’, as opposed to a ‘driven man’. Isaiah was the same, pulled by a vision.

- Story of the ‘discourager’
- Isaiah stayed true to his vision

Don Quixote’s question: Who is crazy, one who sees world as it is, or as it can be?

The prophet’s eternal question, his blessing and his curse

- most of us aren’t satisfied with the world as it is
- Isaiah recognized the vision God gave him, and worked toward it
